



## RULES

- 1. The "numbers" will be issued on a first come, first served basis and will only be available from the promoter of the lottery Colum O'Driscoll.
- 2. The Association reserves the right to alter the Rules of the "100 Club" from time to time, as may be necessary. A copy of the current Rules will be available on our website <u>www.oidignatians.co.uk</u>.
- 3. All profits made by the "100 Club" will be used to support the Association and its objectives.
- 4. The subscription will be £2 per month, per number, payable by Standing Order on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of each month (or annually by a single payment of £24, to be made a week before a draw). On receipt of a single annual payment or receipt of funds via Standing Order, the applicant will be allocated a Draw Number. For each additional £2 paid per month (or single annual payment of £24), an additional Draw Number will be allocated.
- 5. The fee for each number can be paid monthly by standing order; or paid annually in advance by cash or cheque. Cheques should be made payable to Old Ignatians Social Committee.
- 6. Each "number" is deemed to have been reserved for one year from the first draw and the 11 draws following, purchased at £2 a number.
- 7. Each number purchased will be entered into the monthly draw for three prizes.
- 8. Individuals can join at anytime during the year having paid the appropriate fee and will be entered into the next monthly draw.
- 9. To qualify for a monthly draw the member must have paid their fee covering the respective monthly draw to be able to participate.
- 10. No "100 Club" participant will be included in the draw if the appropriate subscription has not been received by the 5<sup>th</sup> working day of the month in which the draw is taking place. The Promoter reserves the right to reallocate any Draw Numbers where payment has not been received on time.
- 11. There are no restrictions in the quantity of numbers purchased by applicants, but applicants must be over 16 years of age to participate.
- 12. The draws will take place on the second Saturday of each month, in the presence of at least 3 committee members, typically at the Clubhouse. Where it is not possible to undertake a draw, on that day, it will take place on the following weekend.

- 13. The winners will be advised by telephone or email (as applicable) as soon as practicable after the draw has taken place.
- 14. The results will be published on the notice board in the entrance to the Clubhouse and on the Old Ignatian Association website <u>www.oidignatians.co.uk</u>.
- 15. All prize money paid out will be by either cheque or bank transfer.
- 16. The total income collected will be split 50% towards prize money and 50% to the Old Ignatian Association funds.
- 17. The prize fund will be split into 12 monthly sets of draws each consisting of three prizes split as follows one of 60% (first), one of 30% (second) and one of 10% (third) rounded to the nearest pound.
- 18. In a dispute, the decision of the promoter is final.
- 19. The 100 Club will only operate if there are 70 or more numbers taken up.
- 20. Participants can cancel their entry in the Lottery at any time by giving one month's written/email notice to the Promoter (and if paying by Standing Order, they should inform their bank). Any decision by Old Ignatian Association to wind up the "100 Club" will also be by one month's written notice. Under no circumstances can any payments be refunded.
